Suspension of the Recognition of Foreign Medical Schools

The public is hereby informed that the Sri Lanka Medical Council, at its 567th meeting held on 29th July 2016 decided to suspend the recognition granted to the following foreign medical schools for the purpose of the admission of Sri Lankan students for their medical degrees.

(1) Virgen Milagrosa University Foundation College of Medicine, Philippines

Based on the finding of the re-evaluation of the medical course of the above institute, the SLMC decided to suspend the recognition for the purpose of admission of Sri Lankan students for their medical degrees with immediate effect.

(2) Angles University Foundation School of Medicine, Philippines

Based on the findings of the re-evaluation of the medical course of the above institute, the SLMC decided to suspend the recognition for the purpose of admission of Sri Lankan students for their medical degrees with immediate effect.

The Sri Lankans who wish to follow medical courses overseas and then wish to sit for the Examination for Registration to Practice Medicine (ERPM) of the SLMC are **strictly advised** **NOT** to enroll themselves with the above foreign medical schools.

The SLMC will not recognize the qualifications of students who have gained admission to the above medical schools after this notification.
